Vol III p 1015 **13971b. Michael Hoopes Calhoon** died March 19, 2001 at the age of 18. Calhoon, a Northside High School senior, had been battling acute myeloblastic leukemia for almost a year. His mother said, "He had a lot of courage and a lot of heart, and that's what went last – his heart." Mike was a drummer with Terry's Fault, a rock music band that he and some friends started in 1998, playing '70s and modern rock. Mike's last gig was on New Year's Eve at the City Market in downtown Roanoke. He also played for a few hours at the Mike Aid rock music festival, on new drums donated by the Make-A-Wish Foundation, but had to return to the hospital afterward. The event at the Northside High School football stadium was organized by Mike's friends as a fund-raiser to help his family with medical expenses. "Music was his life," his mother said. His lifelong friend Terry Peters, who plays bass in Terry's Fault, called Mike the "master or music trivia" and "the best drummer I'd ever seen in my life." Mike had played the drums for six years.

"He gave strength to a lot of his friends," his mother said. "They were always his first worry." His friends said, "Even in the end, he was still laughing and smiling with us. I mean, he never gave up." Known as an optimist he was "always giving the thumbs up."

Mike Calhoon had been accepted to Holy Cross College in Indiana with plans to transfer to Notre Dame University and study music production. "He had a lot going for him and he kept that in sight," his mother said. "But he said if things didn't work out, he was ready to go." Mike, a Roanoke County native, was also a pole-vaulter for the Northside High School track team before his diagnosis. He was a member of St. Andrew's Catholic Church. Mike is survived by his parents, Rick and Ann Calhoon, and his brother, Chris.

Vol. II, pg. 273: As printed in "**5540. SARAH SOPHIA HOOPES**" the id # is incorrect. It should read "5640". {Rationale: On page 273, Vol. II, Sarah Sophia Hoopes is identified as the d/o Warner Hoopes. However, on page 581, Vol. I, the daughter of Warner Hoopes, Sarah Sophia Hoopes, is id# 5640. Furthermore, as shown on page 569 of Vol. I, id# 5540 is assigned to a William Baldwin Hoopes s/o of Elwood Hoopes. Additionally, on page 247 of Vol. II, is printed the biographical sketch for "5540. WILLIAM BALDWIN HOOPES". Therefore, the id# number in question on page 273 of Vol. II appears to be the one in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 304: As printed under "**5679. HARRIET ELIZABETH HOOPES**", the husband's middle name "NESON" is incorrect. It should read "NELSON".

{Rationale: On pages 783 through 785 of Vol. II, James Nelson Reid is identified as the father of "8496. JOSEPH NELSON REID", "8497. ROBERT HARLAND REID" and "8498. MABEL EDNA REID" who are cited, on page 304, as the children of Harriet Elizabeth Hoopes. Therefore, the name "NESON" in question on page 304 of Vol. II appears to be in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 305: As printed in "5680. MABEL ALICE HOOPES" the id # is incorrect. It should read "5681". {Rationale: On page 305, Vol. II, Mabel Alice Hoopes is identified as the d/o William Harlan Hoopes. However, on page 583 of Vol. I, id# 5680 is assigned to a Ida Adelaide Hoopes, sister of a Mabel (or Mary) B. Hoopes (id# 5681). It would appear that the authors of Volume II had new information and had revised the name of Mabel (or Mary) B. Hoopes (Vol. I) to Mabel Alice Hoopes. Unfortunately the wrong id# number was used on page 305 of Vol. II.}

Vol. II, pg. 336: As printed under "**5754. JAMES FRANKLIN 'FRANK' HOOPES**", issue by Margaret Alice (Edmonson) Hoopes; the id # of her first child, Carl J. Hoopes, is incorrect. It should read "8702" rather than "8902".

{Rationale: The id# "8902" is associated with two different individuals; Carl J. Hoopes on page 336 of Vol. II and Ernest Arthur Hoopes on page 356 of Vol. II (under "5904. EARNEST ALBERT HOOPES"). From the sequence numbering used for id#'s on page 336 of Vol. II one would suspect that 8902 should be 8702. Furthermore, on page 856 of Vol. II, id# 8902 is used for Ernest Arthur Hoopes. Therefore, the number shown on page 336 must be the one in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 430: As printed in "6651. MARGARET LOUISE HOOPES" the id # is incorrect. It should read "6451".

{Rationale: On page 430, Vol. II, Margaret Louise Hoopes is identified as the d/o George Strode Hoopes.

However, on page 80 of Vol. II, id# 6651 is assigned to a Gaston Albin Buffington. On pages 59 & 60 of Vol. II, Margaret Louise Hoopes (id# 6451) is shown as a d/o "4041. GEORGE STRODE HOOPES". Therefore, the number shown on page 430 must be in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 432: As printed in "6495. JOHN EDWARD HOOPES" the id # is incorrect. It should read "6459". {Rationale: On page 432, Vol. II, John Edward Hoopes is identified as the s/o Edward Garfield Hoopes. However, on page 65 of Vol. II, id# 6495 is assigned to a Frances McCormick. On pages 61 & 62 of Vol. II, John Edward Hoopes (id# 6459) is shown as a s/o "4052. EDWARD GARFIELD HOOPES". Therefore, the number shown on page 432 must be in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 713: As printed under "8244. CLARINDA KNAPP ALLEN", the id # for her child, Judith Wilcox, is incorrect. It should read "11811" rather than "11181".

{Rationale: On page 713, Vol. II, Judith Wilcox is identified as the d/o Clarinda Knapp Allen. However, on page 626 of Vol. II, id# 11181 is assigned to a Jerry Jay Hoopes, s/o "7767. JAY WILLIAM HOOPES". On page 1070 of Vol. III, is the biographical paragraph for "11181. JERRY JAY HOOPES". On page 1171 of Vol. III, is the biographical paragraph for "11811. JUDITH WILCOX", d/o Thomas Feris and Clarinda Knapp (Allen) Wilcox. Therefore, the id # for Jerry Hoopes is "11181" and the id # for Judith Wilcox is "11811", hence the number shown on page 713 must be in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 734: As printed in "8257. JONATHAN LUND HOOPES" the id # is incorrect. It should read "8267".

{Rationale: On page 734, Vol. II, Jonathan Lund Hoopes is identified as the s/o Jonathan Nielsen Hoopes. However, on page 270 of Vol. II, id# 8267 is assigned to Jonathan Lund Hoopes the s/o Jonathan Nielsen Hoopes. Furthermore, on page 724 of Vol. II, is the biographical paragraph "8257. ANNIE MELISSA HOOPES", who is the d/o Daniel Lewis Hoopes. That is confirmed on pages 266 through 269 in the biographical paragraph "5632. DANIEL LEWIS HOOPES" where Annie Melissa Hoopes has the assigned id# 8257. Therefore, the number shown on page 734 must be in error.}

Vol. II, pg. 869: As printed in "8794. BARKLEY CLOYD BALDWIN" the id # is incorrect. It should read "8974".

{Rationale: On page 869, Vol. II, Barkley Cloyd Baldwin is identified as the s/o Harrison Dowell Baldwin. However, on page 368 of Vol. II, in the biographical paragraph "5978. CLARA PHEBE HOOPES", id# 8974 is assigned to Barkley Cloyd Baldwin. Furthermore, on page 844 of Vol. II, is the biographical paragraph "8794. FRANK GILLETTE HOOPES", who is the s/o Alvin Marshall Hoopes. That is confirmed on pages 345 & 346 in the biographical paragraph "5788. ALVIN MARSHALL HOOPES" where Frank Gillette Hoopes has the assigned id# 8794. Therefore, the number shown on page 869 of Vol. II must be in error.}

Vol. III, pg. 895: As printed in "9159. HARRY (JIZHENG) TU" the id # is incorrect. It should read "9169". {Rationale: On page 895, Vol. III, Harry (Jizheng) Tu is identified as the s/o Muriel Hoopes. However, on pages 392 through 395 of Vol. II, in the biographical paragraph "6232. MARION VIRGINIA HOOPES", id# 9169 is assigned to Harry (Jizheng) Tu. Furthermore, on page 391 of Vol. II, is the biographical paragraph "6226. ELTHERA MELISSA HOOPES", who is the m/o Linda Clara Barber (id# 9159). The id numbering sequences on both page 391, Vol. II and page 395, Vol. II are orderly, hence correct. Therefore, id# 9159 is for Linda Clara Barber and id# 9169 is for Harry (Jizheng) Tu.which means the number shown on page 895 of Vol. III must be in error.}
